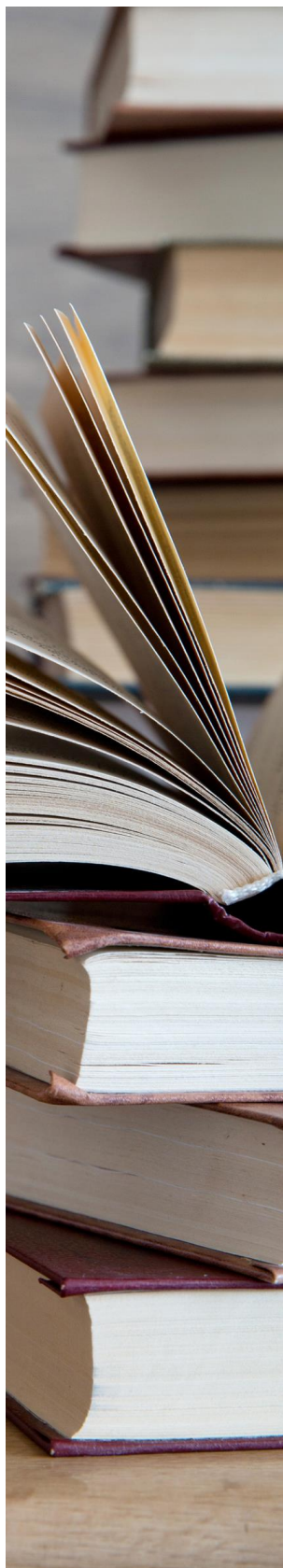
Karla Gavin, author of *Calming the Creative Chaos: Quotes for Everyday Life*, began

Browse these books in the catalog (Featured Displays→HAWC Partnerships) to view titles added to the collection. ♦

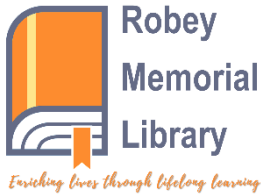
