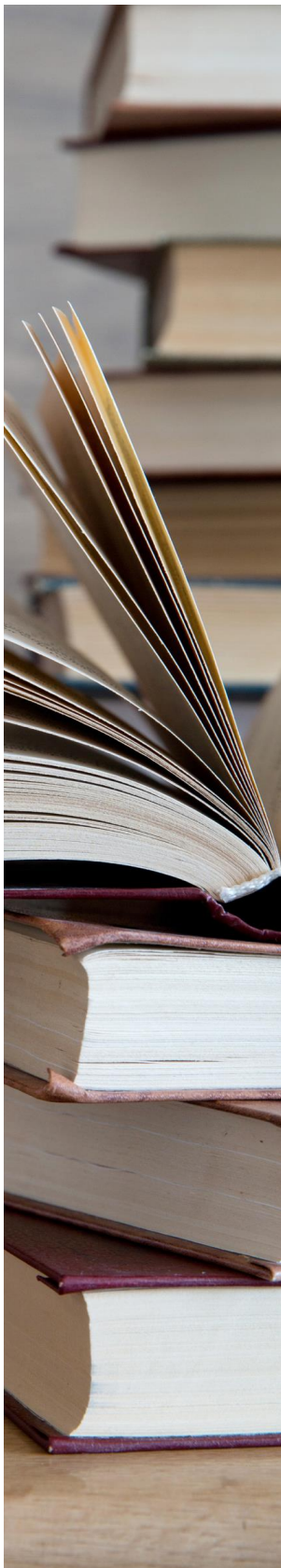
On Thursday, December 29th at 1:30pm we will be showing the movie *Scoob!*:

This bi-monthly class features a project found on Pinterest and all materials will be provided by the library.

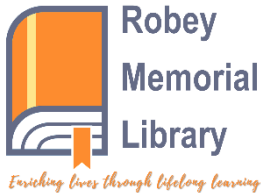

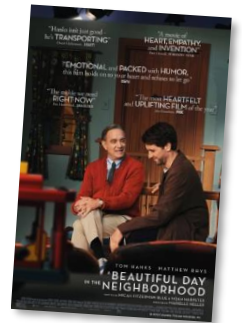
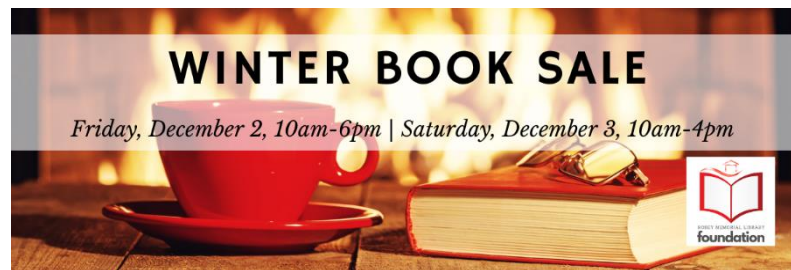
