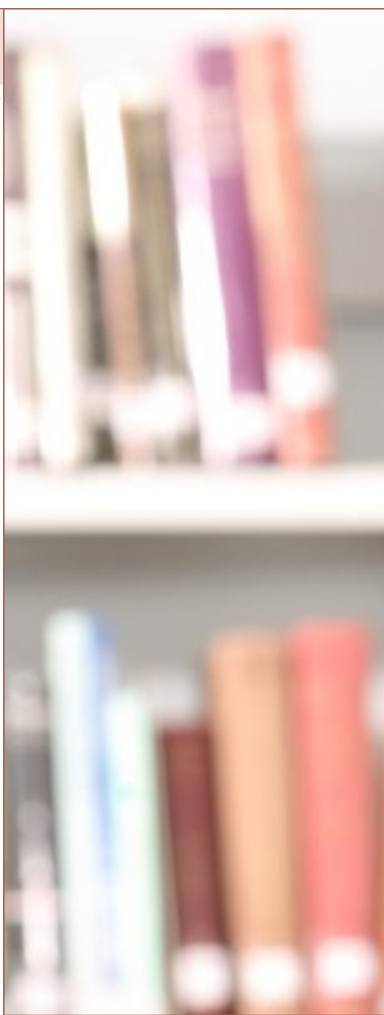



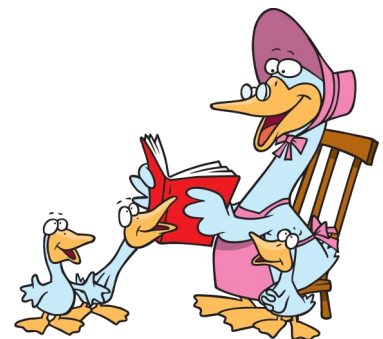
THURSDAY NIGHT BOOK CLUB

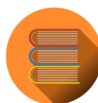
