Table Game Day

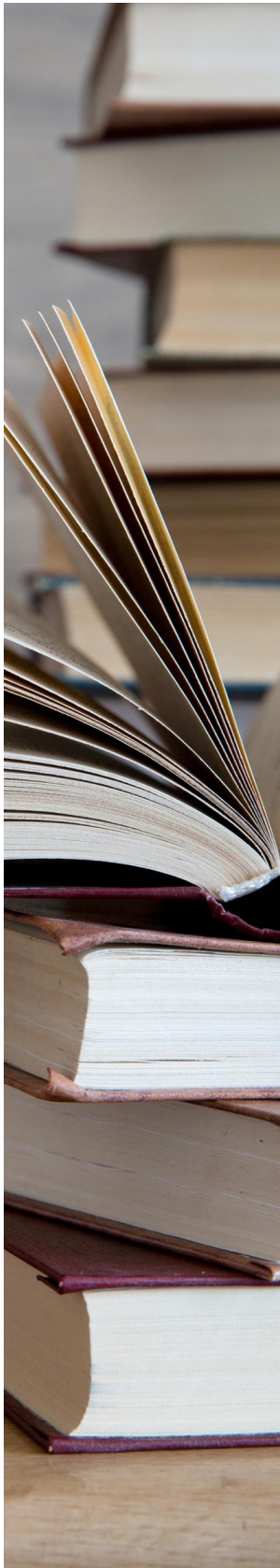

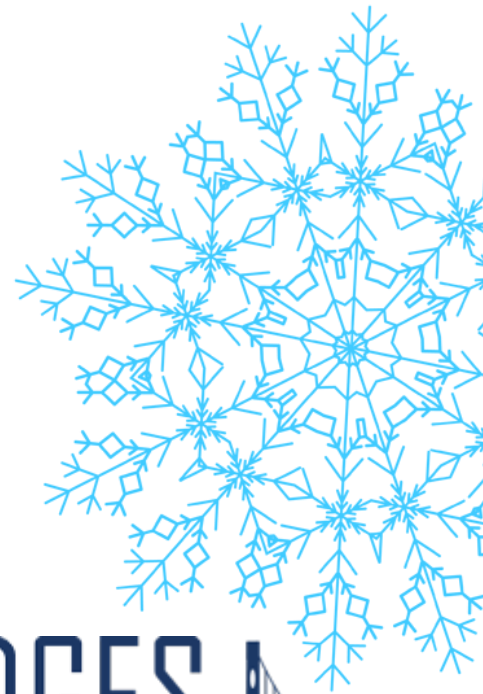
complete all twelve categories.

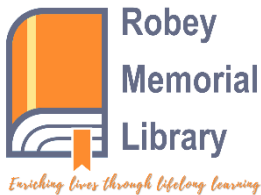
