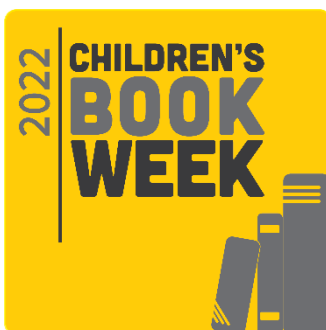

One Week, One Book Reading Challenge

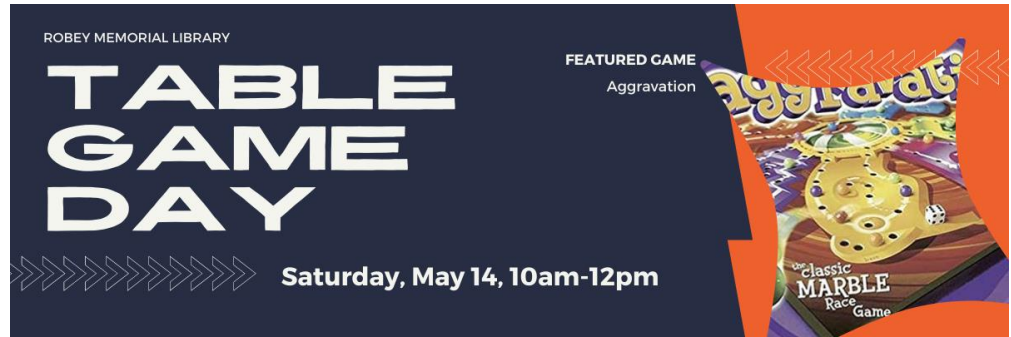
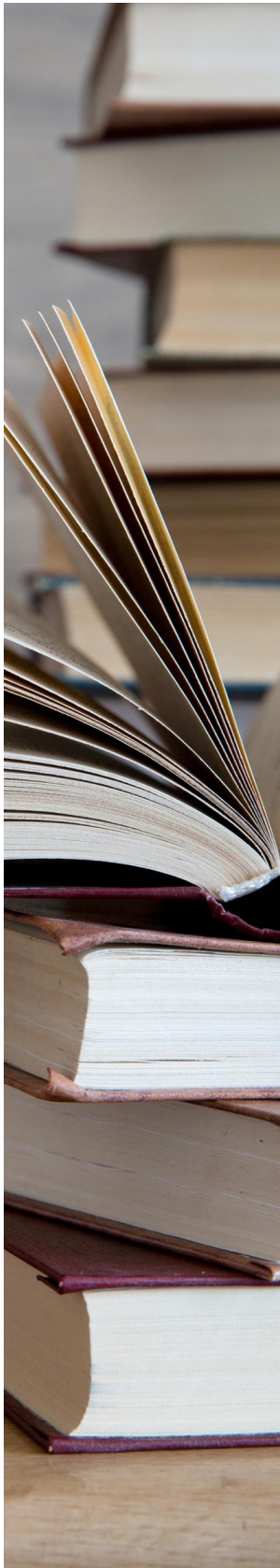
