
Guidelines for show & tell items:

When Ellen Thiele began her library career in 1994 she was following in familiar footsteps. Her mother, Mrs. Ellen Thiele, served on Robey's Board of Trustees for 25 years. During that time the library moved from City Hall to its current location on First Avenue. Ellen's work as a librarian saw the further expansion of the library in 2014. Ellen's career alongside her mother's years of service, has profoundly impacted the Waukon community and made Robey Memorial Library become a in cultural leader community life.


